Finding KUKAN – A "Lost" Documentary

In the award-winning documentary *Finding KUKAN*, Robin Lung investigates the compelling story of Hawai'i born Li Ling-Ai, the uncredited producer of *KUKAN*. *KUKAN* is a landmark color documentary about World War II China that received an Academy Award in 1942 before becoming "lost" for decades. In *Finding KUKAN*, Lung discovers a badly damaged print of *KUKAN* and pieces together the inspirational tale behind Li and her cameraman Rey Scott. Robin Lung will show clips from *Finding KUKAN* and speak about lessons learned during her 8-year filmmaking journey.

Robin Lung is a 4th generation Chinese American from Hawai'i with an 18-year history of bringing untold minority and women's stories to film. A Stanford University and Hunter College graduate, she became a filmmaker after successful careers in book publishing and higher education. Lung made her directorial debut with Washington Place: Hawai'i's First Home, a 30-minute documentary for PBS Hawai'i about the legacy of Hawai'i's Queen Lili'uokalani and her personal home. She was the associate producer for the national PBS documentary Patsy Mink: Ahead of the Majority, and producer/director of the feature documentary *Finding KUKAN*, which was selected to be broadcasted nationally on PBS World's America ReFramed series and has won multiple awards at film festivals across America.
